The Gitga'at Oceans and Lands Department (GOLD) is currently seeking two (2) qualified candidates for Seasonal Remote Field Technicians working out of our remote monitoring cabin at Rennison Island, to conduct field and marine surveys and monitor nearby portions of the territory. This position will report directly to the Guardian Operations Manager.

Duties to include:

- Maintain the cabin and complete minor repairs and upgrades as required,
- Collect data and photographs following developed protocols,
- Follow communication protocols to stay connected with GOLD staff,
- Keep all data and photographs properly organized and catalogued,
- Operating and maintaining GOLD's and other equipment such as boats, survey equipment, powersaws and other tools; and
- Ensure all data and photographs collected are given to GOLD's data manager timely.

The ideal applicant will:

- Have training and experience in performing resource surveys/assessments,
- Have experience with operating and using field equipment,
- Have experience and preferably certification in small vessel operation and maintenance,
- Have or be able to complete valid First Aid Training,
- Be reliable and self-motivated with good organization and technical skills,
- Be able to work in a team environment and understand land and marine resource issues,
